

Horizontal and Vertical Ridge Augmentation

Many techniques and augmentation materials have been described for horizontal and vertical ridge augmentation. These include guided bone regeneration (GBR), ridge expansion/ splitting, autogenous onlay block grafting, titanium mesh techniques, distraction osteogenesis, and interpositional osteotomy. While many techniques offer excellent results, in some situations few can be said to guarantee success. Many questions remain on which methods yield the most predictable results for dental implant placement in grafted bone. The aim of this lecture is to critically evaluate the current evidence to determine the predictability of various bone augmentation techniques for horizontal and vertical ridge defects for implant placement. A series of cases have been gathered to illustrate risk assessment and predictable management of various critical size defects ranging from moderate to severe.

FEATURED SPEAKER

Bach Le, DDS, MD

Dr. Bach Le completed his specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Oregon Health Sciences University. He is currently Clinical Associate Professor of Oral and Maxillo-



facial Surgery at the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry at USC. Dr. Le has lectured extensively on dental implantrelated surgery and has taught on six continents around the world. He has authored or co-authored over 13 chapters in textbooks on bone regeneration and dental implants and has published extensively in professional peer-review journals. Dr. Le served as editor of the Dental Implant section of the recognized Fonseca Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery textbook (3rd edition) which was recently released in 2017. He has been a main podium speaker at numerous national organizations including the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, the Academy of Osseointegration, the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry, American Academy of Implant Dentistry, the American College of Prosthodontists, the Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontists, and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. Dr. Le was recently inducted as an Honorary Member of the American College of Prosthodontists in 2014 and is a recipient of the Charles E. English Award in Clinical Science. Dr. Le is a Diplomate of the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, the American Dental Society of Anesthesiologists, and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. Dr. Le holds Fellowship in the American College of Dentists, the International College of Dentists and the International Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons.
